

Guidelines Related to Serving Alcohol and Substance Misuse

Procedures

No person under the age of 21 years should be served alcoholic beverages.

When in doubt of an individual's age, ask for the person's driver's license.

An individual who demonstrates evidence of alcohol or substance misuse should no longer be served alcoholic beverages.

If a person shows evidence of substance misuse or disorderly conduct, they may be asked to leave the premises. Law enforcement should be called if the person is causing a disturbance. An Incident Report may need to be filed.

The Symphony Office should be contacted regarding Liability Insurance and should be contacted after any substance misuse incident.

Alcoholic beverages cannot be sold at events, but can be given away as part of the admission price. Otherwise, additional coverage must be purchased.

Contacts

The Symphony CFO should be contacted in the Executive Office regarding insurance coverage and liability insurance related to the serving of alcohol for Society events.
