The Orchestra

Since its founding in 1961, the Southwest Florida Symphony Orchestra has developed into one of the finest regional orchestras in the country.



This season we will be selecting a new Artistic Director. Four candidates will each conduct a Masterworks concert at Barbara B. Mann PAH. The audience will be invited to add their input to the selection committee.

The concert season includes 4 Masterworks and 2 Pops programs, Holiday TinyPops, and several smaller programs throughout the season. The Orchestra also supports an array of outstanding educational programs including the Youth Orchestra and ensembles, the Majors for Minors program that brings musicians to the schools, and annual Young People's Concert performances for grade school students. Ticket sales contribute only about one-third of the orchestra's \$1.5 million budget.
